

Values Education

Our theme for Personal, Social, Health and Emotional Education this half term is 'Getting on and Falling Out'. We will be focusing on the value of **Thoughtfulness**. You can support this element of our curriculum at home by noticing and celebrating thoughtful behaviour. This work includes our current anti-bullying week. This Friday children can **come to school dressed in blue** to show their support for our anti bullying campaign.

We do not raise money for Children in Need on the 17th November because we do not want to dilute our focus on our anti bullying campaign. We are also very aware that we have just sold poppies and that parents are paying for their child's Christmas cards. We will be holding a Christmas charity collection during our school concerts.

Reception Concerts

Party Day ends with an after school disco between 3pm and 4pm. Booking and payment is via Parentmail. Teachers will be running three discos over the year. These come as a package for £9. Booking a single disco will cost £3.50 to cover the Parentmail administration charge. The money raised by teachers at discos is used to enhance the curriculum by funding performance groups and supporting school visits.

Christmas Cards

In December, there will be post boxes in the Reception and Nursery shared areas, and in the KS1 building corridor. To aid delivery, cards will need to have the recipient's full name and their class on the envelope. Class lists will be available from teaching staff.
