Parent Visits

Now that the children are settled in school, teachers will be putting up a calendar for parents to book a visit to their child's class. Do come in if you can to join in with a lesson.

Attendance

Regular attendance at school is essential for children's social and academic success.

Attendance below 95% is a cause for concern. If your child's attendance falls below this level we will write to you to ensure that you are aware of this fact. Children who miss 23 or more days are classed as 'persistent absentees' by the DfE. Whatever the reason for the absence, we will be working with children and families to improve attendance levels. This work can be supported by the school nurse or the Children and Family Practices Team. We also issue Fixed Penalty Notices where this is necessary.

We cannot authorise holidays in term time. A week's holiday combined with time off with sickness easily lowers attendance below the required 95% and often into 'persistent absentee' status.

Please always inform us first thing in the morning if your child will be absent. We need to be sure where children are and that they are safe.

Planned absences must always be applied for two weeks in advance.

Staff Absence

Staff have worked exceptionally hard this half term to ensure the best provision for the children. Extra pressure has been caused by the fact that we have faced five absences due to surgery and recovery time. Despite this pressure we have had a successful seven weeks; we are proud of how well the children have settled into their new classes. Do look at the new displays around school to see what the children have been learning and how well their skills are progressing.

School Partners

We have been successful in gaining some Erasmus funding for a mathematics project with our partner Swedish School. Our project is entitled 'Adventures in Mathematics' and will focus on creating real and exciting contexts for learning and applying mathematics. Two teachers from Sweden will be visiting us during the week beginning 14th November.
