## Welcome to our new families and welcome back to our established families

We have had a happy and calm start to the new school year. We are very impressed with how well children are settling into their new routines. ### **Parent Support**

If you have time for a regular slot to help in school then please see your class teacher. Parents can help with display, hearing readers, gardening, looking after our library etc. Training offered. We particularly appreciate the support of Forest School helpers as this provision can only take place if we have enough adults to walk the children to the site.

### **Children's Birthdays**

We celebrate children's birthdays with a song and a birthday sticker. Please note that we do not hand out sweets or share cakes etc. If you wish to treat your child's class then a new story book is always welcome for story time.

### Wrap Around Care - Drop Off:

Nursery and Reception children need to be brought down the path on lane side of school and be dropped off at the Nursery and Reception entry doors. If they have older siblings these can then be taken to Mrs Styles at the WAC playground gate. Year 1 and 2 children (without Early Years siblings) need to be brought across the main playground to the WAC building.

#### Places

Wrap Around Club places are in huge demand this year. For the first time we have had to introduce a waiting list. We are sorry that we are unable to be more flexible and meet parental need. This is due to the size of the building and the adult to child ratios.

#### **Harvest**

The children will have a Harvest Assembly on Friday 22<sup>rd</sup> September. For this event we will be collecting food for the Milton Keynes Food Bank. Please bring in donations of dried, UHT and tinned foods from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September. Boxes for the collection will be positioned outside classrooms.

### Is your child eligible for Pupil Premium?

Please continue to apply for Pupil Premium (the old free school meals grant) if you are eligible. This money has a significant impact on our funding. It allows us to offer the eligible children free clubs, including infant strings, and visits. It also ensures that we can maintain Reading Recovery, Numbers Counts and other targeted provision.

### **Covered playground**

Our quiet playground is now completely covered. We are very grateful to the Parents' Association for their support with fundraising for the cover. We are now working on building up resources for the area.
