Parent Support

Wrap Around Care

Remember that, along with our Breakfast Club, we also offer after-school care to support working parents.

The sessions run from 3pm to 6pm Monday to Friday. The cost is £9.00 per session and includes a snack time. Activities include PE, art, technology, cooking, free play and Spanish.

Bookings and payment will need to be:

- made in advance by Parentmail or by Childcare vouchers (we will need to know the provider for vouchers eg : ComputerShare, Edenred & Co-op)
- booked and paid monthly **in advance** by the end of the preceding month

Tummy Bugs

Please keep children off school for 48 hours after a tummy bug. This stops the bug from spreading through school.

Please comb through your child's hair weekly with a fine tooth comb and hair conditioner. This will prevent lice from multiplying and spreading.

Football Cards

We are currently allowing cards in school. Children need to be prepared to lose cards if they bring them in. If the cards begin to cause disagreements and strife then we may need to review this policy!

Is your child eligible for Pupil Premium?

Please, please continue to apply for Pupil Premium (the old free school meals grant) if you are eligible. This money has a significant impact on our funding. It allows us to offer the eligible children free clubs, including infant strings, and visits. It also ensures that we can maintain Reading Recovery and Numbers Counts provision for those children who need it. This provision impacts on learning for all children; the pitch of teaching is raised across classes as a result of closing the gap in attainment.
