School Budget

As explained in our last newsletter, we are facing significant budgetary pressures. We are looking at every penny we can save to try to maintain staffing levels into the future. We also have to look at ways that we can generate additional funding ourselves.

A small thing that parents can do for us <u>is not to</u> <u>order school meals that are not required.</u> We pay for those meals from our budget and every £2 that we save goes towards provision for our children. If a child orders a school meal and brings in a lunch box, we will be expecting them to eat the school meal.

We have had a good take up of places for Reception next academic year which is a great help. We do still have vacancies in our current Year 1 and in next year's Nursery class.

<u>Volunteers from Santander</u> did a great job of painting our outdoor furniture and railings over Easter. We are grateful for their time and for the money their hard work has saved us!
