Dinosaur Day - Year Two – Wednesday 10th January Discover the wonder of the dinosaurs

Year 2 children will be taking part in 'Our Life Long Ago - fossil dig workshop' bringing prehistoric life to school. The children will locate and identify fossils from some of the most iconic dinosaurs of the past. Tyrannosaurus Rex, Stegosaurus, Triceratops and a few other surprises. The children will learn when each dinosaur lived, where they came from, what they ate and much more.

During the workshop children will have a visit from a large and baby dinosaurs, where an expert dinosaur handler will introduce the hatchlings whilst explaining about their family, diet, habitat and what the era was like millions of years ago.
