Over the Summer Term teachers will be making formal assessments of children's learning to inform report writing and for data submission to the government. Please be assured that all assessments will be part of our normal teaching day and will not be conducted as 'tests'. There are materials that we are required to use for Year 1 phonics and for Year 2 English and Maths but these will be integrated into lessons and into individual or group assessment sessions with teachers. You might find that Year 2 children come home excited about the workbooks they have used at school – these are assessment activities. They are always popular with the children!
