

Literacy

Our topic will be focusing on Superworm, Super Daisy and Super Tato. We will be designing our own superheroes and writing sentences about them using describing words. We will be looking at the non-fiction books and learning how to use them, using the contents and index pages. We will continue to use phonics to help with our reading and writing.

Mathematics

We will be focusing combining two groups to find out how many altogether. We will be using a part-whole method to show the relationships between the parts and the whole. We will introduce the children to number bonds to 10 using a tens frame and the part-whole method. We will begin to use positional language to describe how items are positioned in relation to other objects. We will introduce the children to the names of 2D and 3D shapes, looking at similarities and differences. They will be encouraged to see 2D shapes on the flat faces of 3D shapes.

Physical Development

In our P.E. lessons we will be focusing on dance, learning to move our bodies in different ways. We will develop our fine motor skills through a range of activities including: threading, playdough and cutting. The children will have access to large equipment outside.

Communication and Language

During lessons we will predict what will happen next in the stories we are reading. We will be learning a poem to recite. We will continue to learn to follow simple instructions and sharing our ideas.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term our value is respect, we will be looking at what that means and how we can be respectful. We will be looking staying safe and being aware of strangers.

Expressive Arts and Design

Exploring media and materials: In our music lessons we will be learning a repertoire of new songs. We will be exploring different painting techniques including using water colours and bubble wrap to create different effects.

Being imaginative: We will be using our imagination to design a superhero outfit as well as building 3D models using junk modelling. Using the role play and small world we will be using our imagination to create superhero stories.

Understanding the World

The world: We will be looking at the importance of staying healthy and what we can do to be healthy, including brushing our teeth, exercising and healthy eating. We will go on a walk around Stony Stratford to spot signs of spring.

People and Communities: We will be looking at people in the community who help us, police, shop workers, vets etc.

Technology: We will have regular access to tablets and the Interactive whiteboard to access age appropriate software.
