Our COVID Risk Assessment and Contingency Plan have been updated and are once again on our website. The only main change to note is that if your child is required to isolate, they may now take LFD tests on day 6 and day 7 of their self-isolation period. Those who receive two negative test results are no longer required to complete 10 full days of self-isolation. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 6 of the self-isolation period and tests must be taken 24 hours apart.
