School Visits

Whilst we encourage parents to visit school and to accompany local walks, we do seek to use staff and regular helpers to supervise visits which are longer and further afield. This is to ensure that we are using adults that: have a DBS check, know the code of conduct, are familiar with school policies and whose skills are known to us. Some regular helpers are parents and are assigned groups that do not include their children. To keep the children safe it is important that we have control of the risk factors. It is also a very different experience to go on a visit independently of your parents; visits are a key part of our PSE curriculum.
