School Improvement Priorities

This year there has been a complete change in the OFSTED Inspection Framework. The focus of the framework has been on English and Mathematics; it will now be on the wider curriculum, with more of a focus on children's personal development. We have always valued a broad and balanced curriculum which supports children's personal development. Our development work this year will be on reviewing our existing curriculum and provision, especially the ways that these are evidenced for external evaluation.

We are also continuing to work on last year's mathematics mastery project. In addition, we will be auditing our ICT and International Schools Provision in preparation for re-applying for ICT and ISA Awards.
