# Paper Plate Flying Saucer

## Supplies

- 2 paper bowls
- Paper cup
- PVA glue
- Scissors
- Green Black Yellow and red Paint
- Silver foil
- Pipe cleaners
- Pom-poms
- Googly eyes
- Stick on jewels or sequins



1 Turn both paper bowls upside-down, then choose a paint colour and paint the bottom and rim of each bowl, then leave to dry.



2 Use a different colour to paint the sides of the bowl, then leave to dry.



3 Trim the bottom off the paper cup, then thinly cover in PVA glue.



4 Cover the cup bottom in silver foil, then leave to dry.



5 Using PVA glue, stick the cup bottom on to the middle of one paper bowl, then leave to dry.



6 Next, spread PVA glue around the inside edge of one of the paper bowls. Then join the two bowls together, pressing firmly around the edge of them, before leaving to dry.



7 Where the cup joins the paper bowl, run a line of glue. Then bend a pipe cleaner around and twist the ends together so it sits snugly at the join.



8 Decorate the flying saucer by sticking jewels or sequins around the outside edge of the top paper bowl.

# Paper Plate Flying Saucer



## Supplies

- 2 paper bowls
- Paper cup
- PVA glue
- Scissors
- Green Black Yellow and red Paint
- Silver foil
- Pipe cleaners
- Pom-poms
- Googly eyes
- Stick on jewels or sequins







**Step 1.** Turn both paper bowls upside-down, then choose a paint colour and paint the bottom and rim of each bowl, then leave to dry.



**Step 2.** Use a different colour to paint the sides of the bowl, then leave to dry.



**Step 3.** Trim the bottom off the paper cup, then thinly cover in PVA glue.





**Step 4.** Cover the cup bottom in silver foil, then leave to dry.



**Step 5.** Using PVA glue, stick the cup bottom on to the middle of one paper bowl, then leave to dry.

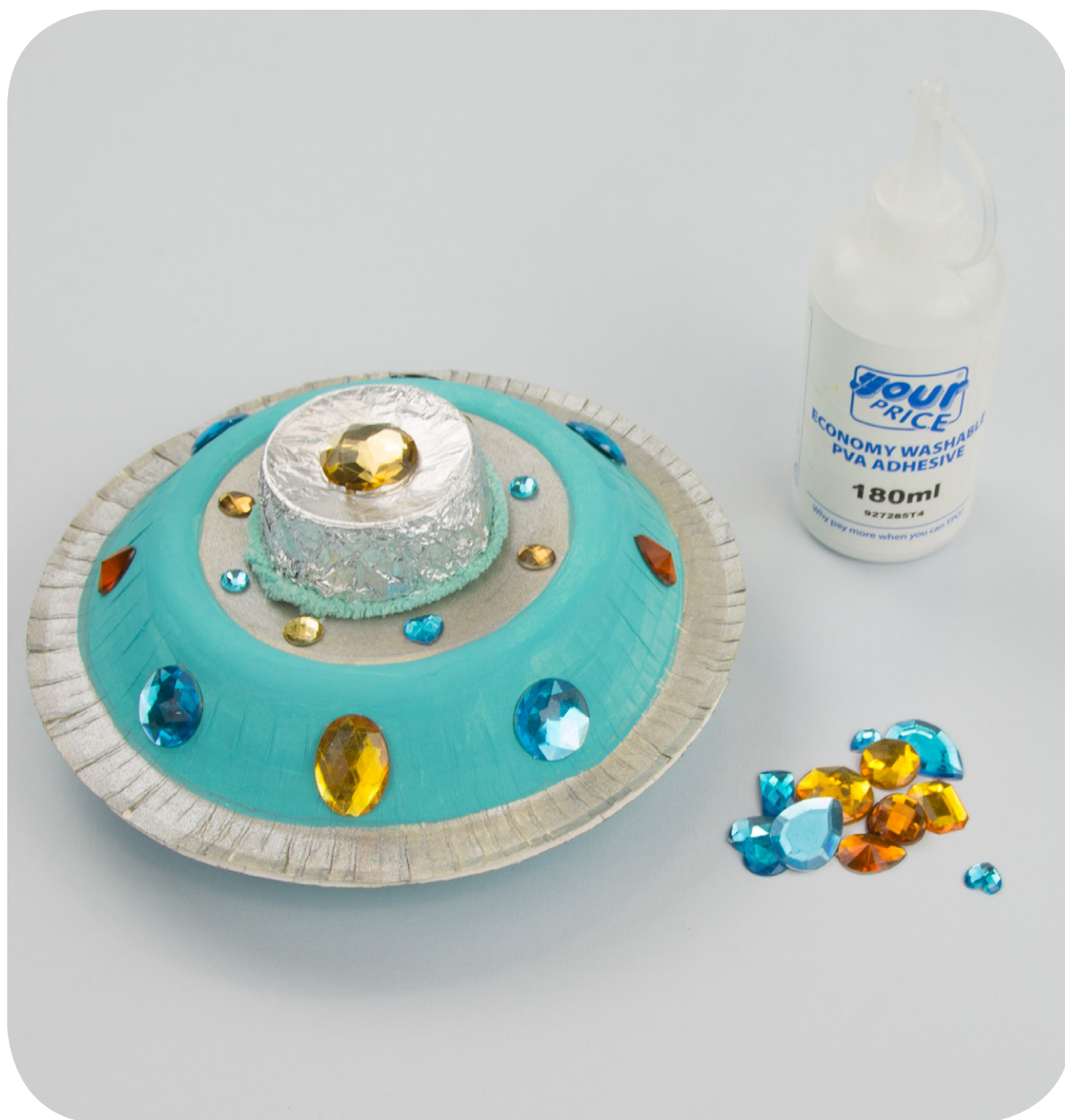




**Step 6.** Next, spread PVA glue around the inside edge of one of the paper bowls. Then join the two bowls together, pressing firmly around the edge of them, before leaving to dry.



**Step 7.** Where the cup joins the paper bowl, run a line of glue. Then bend a pipe cleaner around and twist the ends together so it sits snugly at the join.



**Step 8.** Decorate the flying saucer by sticking jewels or sequins around the outside edge of the top paper bowl.
