# **2Simple Reports**

Early Years parents will have received their child's 2Simple Learning Journey via email. Assessment processes are very different in **Key Stage 1** where the demands of the National Curriculum lead approaches to assessment. Learning Journeys are not a feature of assessment at this stage of learning. In response to parental requests teachers do collect some photographic memories of the year and send these via 2Simple.
